

The Junior Class Council (Class of 2019) is very excited about the upcoming Junior Senior Ball (JSB, otherwise known as the prom), held in honor of the Class of 2018. The theme is “**Illuminate**.” The Ball will be held on **Friday, May 4** (there is no school that day) from 7:30pm to 10:30pm on board the **Argosy Cruise Lines brand new ship, the Salish Explorer**. It will depart at **7:30 p.m. sharp** from **Pier 57**, located at 1301 Alaskan Way. It is located right under the Great Wheel, so it should be easy to find.

**Tickets** are \$30 for seniors and \$60 for juniors. If a junior or a senior invites an underclassman or someone who does not attend King’s, the ticket is \$90; non-King’s students are required to complete a form in advance. Forms are available in the school offices. Ticket sales will take place at school during lunchtime from Wednesday, April 18 to Friday, April 20. Cash, checks, and cards will be accepted. Come one and all, in a group, with friends, or with a date!

**Dress** is formal. The event will be amply **chaperoned** by King’s staff and teachers. David and his team from Classic Image **Photography** (<http://www.classicimagephoto.net>) will again be there to take photos.

**Dining** will be at the individual’s taste and expense prior to the Ball. Given that you must be on board on time, we strongly suggest that you consider one of the many restaurants either along the waterfront or nearby in the area of Pike’s Place market. There is a **Mariner’s game** that night at 7:10 p.m. so coming from farther away is likely to be problematic, as traffic on the access roads in the area is likely to be heavy.

On a recent Friday evening at 7:00 p.m., there was a lot of **parking** in a lot across the street from Pier 57 under the Viaduct, and a garage behind that; between the two, there was plenty of on-street parking along Western Avenue, and a very few on-street pay parking spots on the seafront. On board, we will have a wonderful **dessert** buffet, provided by Dianne’s Delights. The on-board **non-alcoholic bar** will feature our signature Kings’ mocktail, the Sparkle. There will be food, fun and dancing on the ship’s three floors (the top floor is outside under the stars), featuring the DJ who did the music for the last Winter Ball.

The ship will **return** to the same dock at 10:30pm.
